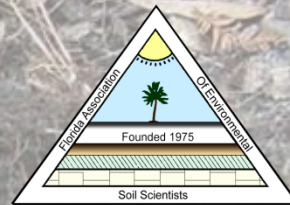

- Earn CEUs for CPSS, PWS, CEHP, etc.



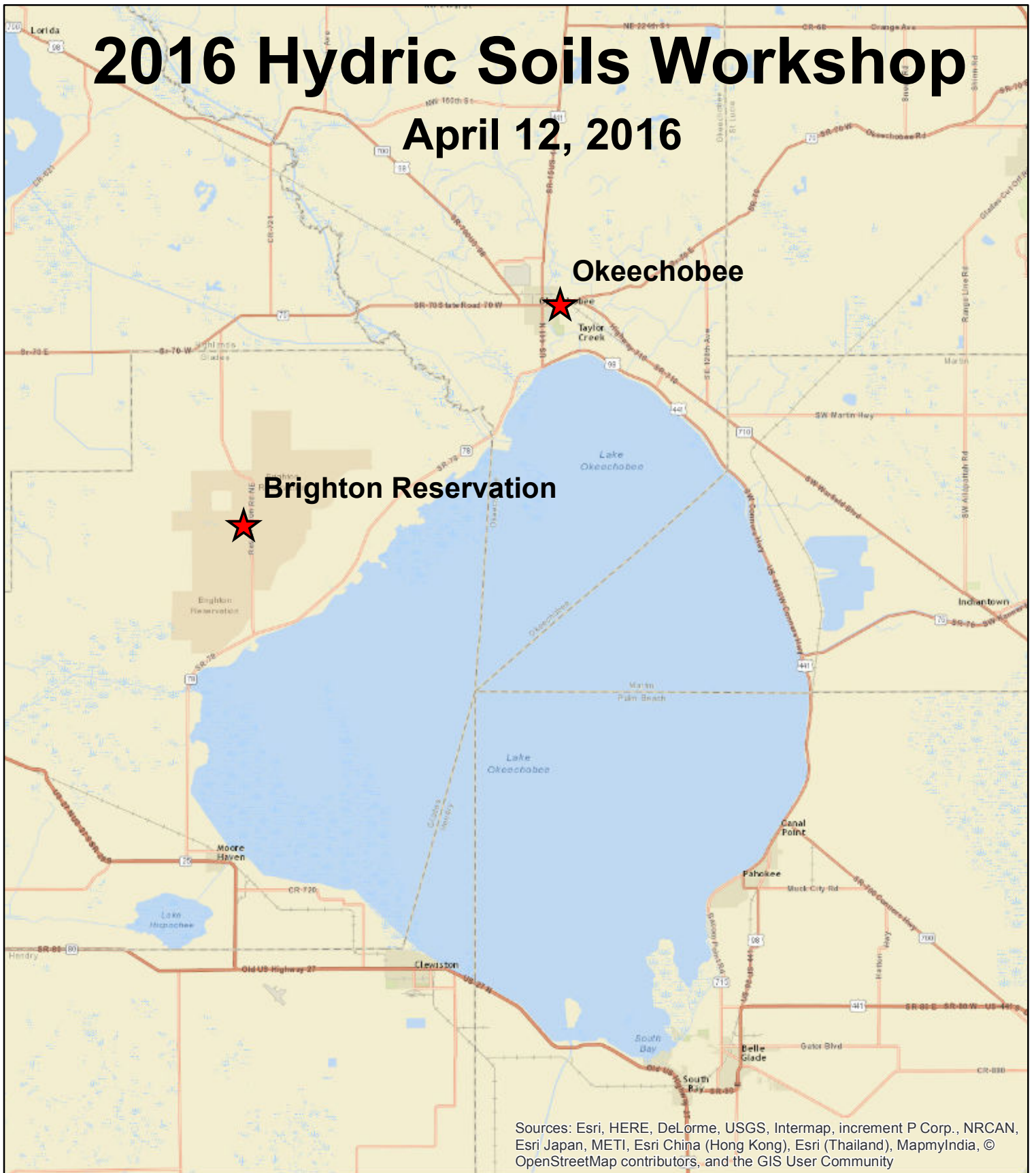
